

Below are the different positions the Recreation Department employs at LoConte Rink. Position Summary:

Zamboni Driver/Shift Supervisor— This position has hours available weekdays after 2:00pm and Saturday and Sundays. The Recreation Department will train new hires on how to drive the Zamboni and certify staff with CPR and First Aid. Applicants must be age 18 or older and have a valid drivers license.

Rink Attendant: This position has hours available weekdays and weekends. Applicants must be age 14 or older. The basic job function of this position will be to keep the facility clean and to collect money from the Skate Shop and Drop In Programs.

Rink Guard: This position has hours available during public skate times and special events. Applicants must be age 16 or older. The Recreation will certify new employees with CPR and First Aid. Applicants must be age 16 or older. The basic job function of this position is to supervise and monitor the ice rink.

HOURS OF WORK: Non benefited, part time, seasonal position. Nights and weekend hours

REQUIREMENTS: At least 18 years old and have a valid driver's license

BASIC FUNCTION:

Reporting to the Recreation Facilities Coordinator, this position will be responsible for the oversight of recreational activities and events at LoConte Ice Rink. Responsible for driving the Zamboni correctly and maintain acceptable ice conditions. Candidates will be trained completely on the operation of the Zamboni.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Maintain a safe and clean facility at all times;
- Assist Rink Attendant with removing trash from bleachers and clean glass;
- Drive the zamboni correctly and maintain acceptable ice conditions;
- Support and monitor other shift staff including skate guards and rink attendants:
- Maintain and enforce ice rink schedule.
- Provide excellent customer service to patrons and organizations visiting the facility;
- Respond to questions and inquiries or direct them to the appropriate department.
- Fill out and complete documents including safety/security checks, cleaning checklist, and daily log report.
- Respond to emergencies including summoning EMS and provide basic first aid if necessary.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES:

- Excellent written and verbal communications skills;
- Ability to work effectively and independently;
- Ability to problem solve, adapt, or interpret instructions accordingly.
- Understand how to prioritize tasks.
- Basic Adult / Child CPR, AED, and First Aid required. Training will be provided if applicant does not currently hold certification.

BASIC FUNCTION:

Reporting to the Recreation Facilities Coordinator, this position will be responsible for keeping the facility clean and collect money for skate rentals and drop in fees.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Maintain a safe and clean facility at all times;
- Sweep and mop the floor.
- Wipe down and sanitize high touched surfaces including tables, door handles, benches, etc...
- Clean bathrooms including sinks and toilets.
- Stock bathroom with paper products.
- Empty trash barrels.
- Clean bleachers and pick up trash.
- Collect money for skate rentals and drop in programs.
- Provide excellent customer service to patrons and organizations visiting the facility;
- Respond to questions and inquiries or direct them to the appropriate department.
- Fill out and complete documents including safety/security checks, cleaning checklist, and daily log report.
- Respond to emergencies including summoning EMS if necessary.
